## **3. Draft Accounts for 2009**

The Treasurer tabled a set of draft accounts for 2009, which were incomplete in that he had been unable to obtain the figures from the Pantomime Group and Flower Guild. The income for both these accounts was “restricted” and hence had a minimal affect on the rest of the accounts. The accounts showed that we had failed to meet the Parish Share for 2009 by approximately £18,000, which had increased the total amount owed to the Diocese for 2009 and previous years to £114,855. It was explained that this debt was not enforceable in law and hence the PCC was not insolvent but there was a moral obligation to meet the debt.

The Chair proposed the following resolution, seconded by Jim :-

**The PCC accepts the accounts provided that the income and expenditure for the Pantomime Group and Flower Guild are included at a later date.**

This was carried with no votes against.

It was noted that a full set of accounts needs to be posted on Church notice boards by the 14<sup>th</sup> April. **Action Treasurer.**
